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## **State Achievement Survey – November 2017**

Providing quality education is a continuous endeavor that requires the empowerment at all levels of school education to define quality in education from time to time. Government of Karnataka initiated good number of programs to guarantee quality in education which has given a new dimension in different aspects of schooling and schooling processes. To accomplish this task and identify the status of schools in the state, Karnataka School Quality Assessment and Accreditation Council (KSQAAC) was constituted in November 2011.

In what is touted to be the largest assessment in India, the Primary and Secondary Education Department, Government of Karnataka carried out a census based State Achievement Survey (CSAS) on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> November 2017 with an aim to assess the learning levels of students. All the students of class 4 to 9, numbering 35.66 lakh, in Government and Aided Schools were assessed. The CSAS assessed learning levels in Languages and Core Subjects (Mathematics, EVS / Science and Social Science). KSQAAC was the main body which planned and implemented the Census based State Achievement Survey. For the past five years, it has conducted sample-based diagnostic test signifying internal capacity of Karnataka to carry out large scale assessments for measuring learning outcomes. It was the in-house capacity of the Government of Karnataka in the form of KSQAAC that made it possible for it to carry out one of the largest learning assessments ever conducted wherein the entire process from planning, conducting the assessment and disseminating results was done in less than 6 months.

In assessing the students, comprehensive competencies of previous class and the present class were given due weightage. Previously learnt contents were given a weightage of 20% and currently learnt contents were given a weightage of 80%. Key competencies as per this weightage were decided in a workshop conducted with practicing school teachers and experts. This formed the basis for preparation of questions and question papers. KSQAAC got technical support from Azim Premji Foundation for scrutiny and review of question papers. For each subject, two sets of question papers, each set with two versions were prepared and given to the students. Optical Mark Reader (OMR) sheets were used to record the answers of students. Each paper contained 24 questions, 18 with one mark each and 6 with 2 mark each, totaling to 30 marks. Each of the questions had four multiple choice's and students were asked to tick the correct answer. There were four types of questions relating to knowledge, understanding, appreciation and expression for language papers. In respect of core subjects, there were three types of questions relating to knowledge, understanding and application. For classes 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>, both Languages and Core papers had 48 questions while for classes 6<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup>, both Language and Core papers had 72 questions each. The OMR sheets were customized with the name of the school, name of the student, his/her SATS ID and question paper set already printed on the sheet for each student with data

from SATS. A total of 896 question paper sets were designed in 9 mediums, namely Kannada, English, Urdu, Marathi, Hindi, Telugu, Tamil, Malayalam and Gujarati. A mock exam was conducted on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2017, with two key objectives. One, to make all teachers and officials aware about the process of conducting the exam. Two, to familiarize students with the question paper format and the OMR sheet. Going through this process helped in identifying and rectifying glitches for the final assessment. The Language assessment was held on 3rd November and the Core Subjects (Mathematics, EVS / Science and Social Science) assessment was held on 4th November.

The question papers and customized OMR sheets were printed and distributed under a centralized process for cost-effectiveness and decentralized process was adopted for processing of answer sheets at the district level because of greater availability of manpower at this level. For faster processing of answer sheets, KSQAAC supplied two / three scanners to each district. Sikshana Foundation was instrumental in developing the technology that allowed scanners to identify tick marks on OMR sheets. Once the sheets were scanned, they were automatically uploaded into two folders - one for language and the other for core subjects. These scanned images of OMR sheets were stored in “tiff format”. After this, the scanned images were sent to a central server managed by Sikshana Foundation through FTP (File transfer protocol). The last process was validation of answers through a software developed by Sikshana. Progress of each district was visible on a central dashboard. The analysis was carried out with due participation and involvement of KSQAAC in accordance with the objectives of SAS i.e. understanding student-specific, school-specific, region-specific and intervention-specific learning levels.

The results were communicated to each child through his/her parent’s in the form of an individual progress report card. Attached to this report was a letter addressed to individual parents, signed by the Headmaster. The achievement survey identified students in each of the school, cluster, block and districts in need of additional teaching support. 10.71 lakh Students who secured less than 35% were identified for remedial teaching. The CSAS was also instrumental in increasing parental involvement in the child’s educational journey and also motivating them to engage more with the school authorities

The data was analysed to prepare reports at the following levels: State, District, Block, Cluster and School level. The DDPIs were asked to analyse the Reports and take appropriate action. This report gives the details about achievement at the State level and the district report cards give the details of students who attended the achievement test by gender, area, management, category and number of children with special needs. The district report also presents class-wise and overall achievement of the district. The district report will help the teachers and education administrators to find out overall achievement of the district vis-à-vis other district and the State in each of the class and subjects.
